Advisory Group**

Adelaide Hills Council Mayor Bill Spragg today announced the appointment of six community representatives to the Stirling Linear Park Advisory Group.

They will join Councillors Simon Jones and John Kemp on the group.

The Stirling Linear Park is a combination of reserves with unique and diverse features, providing multiple recreational, social and conservation opportunities. The group was created to provide advice and guidance for the parks development.

Mayor Spragg said: "People were appointed who have a range of skills, knowledge and expertise required to address the diverse community expectations for using the Park."

"The Council is fortunate to have such a dynamic group from which to receive advice on this important social and environmental asset," said Mayor Spragg. "There is a mix of new and experienced members bringing a good understanding of the Park's history as well as a range of fresh ideas."

Four of the six are reappointments, with Mr Ragless and Ms York being new to the group. All appointments are for a two year term and Council reappointed John Kallin as the group's Chairperson.

A range of initiatives are planned for the Park over the next year including the development of self-guided walks, trail marking for walkers and emergency vehicles, promoting the park as a key social asset and implementing the Bushfire Management Plan.
