## Eligibility

---

The exhibition is open to established and emerging photographers over 16 years of age who reside or are active in the Adelaide Hills Council district. All submissions must be the original work of the photographer.

Completed registration forms must be received by 5pm, Friday 25 January 2019.

## Prizes

---

Five photographs will be chosen by a judging panel to receive a prize of \$500 each. The winning photographs will then form a suite of images that will be used by Adelaide Hills Council in representing cultural diversity in the Adelaide Hills.

Prize winners will be announced at the Opening Night Event, 7pm Thursday 21 March 2019.

## Entry Specifications

---

- Entry is free and photographers may submit a maximum of three photographs.
- Photographs must be framed and ready to hang. The framed work must not exceed A3.
- Requirements for hanging framed work:
  - 'D' rings attached at between one-quarter and one-third depth from the top of the frame
  - Wire made taut, but not tight (no cord)
  - Frames undamaged, neat and tidy; clean glass
- Photographic images must be available electronically in resolution of 1900 x 1000px or higher
- Adelaide Hills Council reserves the right to refuse or limit the overall number of entries

## Sale of Work

---

Council will not sell work on behalf of photographers. The photographer is welcome to list a sale price and contact details in the catalogue if relevant, and interested parties will be advised to contact them directly to facilitate the sale.

## Conditions

---

For the proper and orderly conduct of the exhibition, Adelaide Hills Council reserves the right at its sole discretion to, at any time, without prior notice to the exhibitor, amend, alter, or vary any of the conditions of entry, or reject any entry which they consider does not fit in with the general aims of the exhibition.

Whilst the organisers will exercise all reasonable care, no responsibility will be accepted for any lost or damaged exhibits.

## Delivery of photographs

---

Wednesday 13 March between the hours of 10.00am and 4:00pm to the Coventry Library, Stirling

- Work must be delivered at the photographers own expense
- Photographs will remain on view, whether sold or not, until the close of the Exhibition
- Each work must be clearly labelled, with the details of the work to match the entry form
- Submitted work must correspond with the details provided on the entry form
- All photographs must be ready to hang or display (see "Entry Specifications")

## **Collection of Photographs**

---

Artwork must be collected Monday 8 April between the hours of 10.00am and 4.00pm.

## **Copyright and Content**

---

Copyright of any work submitted remains with the artist. By submitting the work, the photographer agrees that, should their photograph be selected as a winning image, it will be used by Adelaide Hills Council as part of a suite of images for promoting multicultural programs and activities.

The photographer gives the Adelaide Hills Council permission to reproduce, communicate, and display the work to the public, in any publication or platform, for education, resource or publicity purposes. The Council reserves the right to edit or crop images for the purpose of promotion and publicity.
