



Restrictions lifting: What you need to know *Libraries*

Opening hours

Opening hours across our three library branches have been adjusted to the following. The mobile library remains out of service for the time being.

Stirling

Tuesday to Friday, 9am – 5pm
Saturday, 10am – 5pm
Sunday, 1pm – 5pm

Woodside

Monday to Friday, 9am – 5pm
Saturday, 10am – 2pm

Gumeracha

Monday, Wednesday, Friday, 9am – 12pm
Tuesday, Thursday, 2pm – 5pm
Saturday 10am – 1pm

Limited numbers

Patrons must continue to maintain the recommended 1.5m distance between other people at all times.

There are also restrictions on the numbers of people who can occupy an aisle or other confined space within the facility; please look for signs on-site indicating these restrictions.

Activities allowed

- Browsing resources
- Collecting reservations (these will return to the usual holds shelves)
- Self check-out
- Computer use*
- Photocopier use and wireless printing*

*Computers are available in limited numbers at all three branches. Woodside visitors should note that some resources have been moved to accommodate necessary distancing requirements; please speak to staff if you cannot locate what you're looking for.

Contactless service (click/call and collect) remains available by arrangement for those customers who are especially vulnerable or concerned about infection, please call our staff to arrange this.

Whilst some in-person transactions are resuming, we encourage the community to continue to contact us by phone (8408 0400) or [email](#), as staff numbers will be limited and many services are only available remotely while many teams remain working off site.
