The Santos Women's Tour Down Under is coming to Birdwood on Thursday 10 January 2019 for the Stage 1 finish.

Starting their day in Hahndorf, riders will speed up to Lobethal and loop through Gumeracha for two heated sprints, before arriving for a fast and dramatic finish at the National Motor Museum. Explore the Museum for free from 10:00am and enjoy delicious lunch offerings on the shady lawns. Watch the riders fight to the finish line at 1:45pm and join us at the podium to celebrate the winner as they receive their award.

To enable the event to run smoothly and safely, a number of parking and traffic restrictions will be implemented on the day. These restrictions will affect Shannon St between Blumel Rd and Lange Cres from 10:30am to 3:30pm. Enclosed are the full details of the race route and restrictions in the area. Please familiarise yourself with these restrictions and plan your day accordingly. Outside of these restrictions, South Australia Police will manage traffic using 'rolling road closures' and access for emergency services will remain at all times.
