The Santos Women's Tour Down Under is coming to Stirling in 2019 for the finish of Stage 3 on Saturday 12 January 2019.

Starting their day in Nairne, riders will speed through Mylor and into Stirling, turning onto Avenue Road to tackle part of the famous Stirling circuit through Heathfield and Aldgate, before coming to a climb finish at the Stirling Oval. Join us in the Stirling main street from 12:00 noon to watch the riders fly by before their big fight to the finish at the Oval at 1:20pm. Enjoy food and drink around the podium as we celebrate the winner and watch the award ceremony.

To enable the event to run smoothly and safely, a number of parking and traffic restrictions will be implemented on the day. These restrictions will affect Mt Barker Road between Johnston St and Twin St from 10:30am to 3:30pm. Enclosed are the full details of the race route and restrictions in the area. Please familiarise yourself with these restrictions and plan your day accordingly. Outside of these restrictions, South Australia Police will manage traffic using 'rolling road closures' and access for emergency services will remain at all times.
