Stage 3: Finish – Mt Barker Rd, Stirling

Complete road closures - Saturday 12 January 2019

- Mt Barker Rd, Stirling
 - Complete closure from Flight Centre to Oval entrance between 10:30am – 3:30pm
 - Complete closure from Merrion Tce to Twin St between 12:45pm-1:30pm

*These closure times have been put in place for public safety and to allow set up and pack down of event infrastructure. However, we would expect to commence reopening of roads prior to this time.

Rolling road closures

The remainder of the event route will operate under **'rolling' road closures** managed and enforced by SA Police and supported by trained traffic marshalls.

Parking restrictions

No parking will be permitted on the roadside between Merrion Tce and Twin St from 9:00am – 3:30pm. Access to existing off street parking will close only between 12:45pm – 1:30pm.

Public transport

Public bus services will be detoured via Gould Rd and Pomona Rd between 10:00am – 3:30pm. Stop 36 will be temporarily relocated to the freeway entrance and exit ramps during this time. Stops 37 and 38 will not be serviced during this time. Adelaide Metro's website (www.adelaidemetro.com.au) will have up to date information on public transport interruptions and diversions in the coming months. 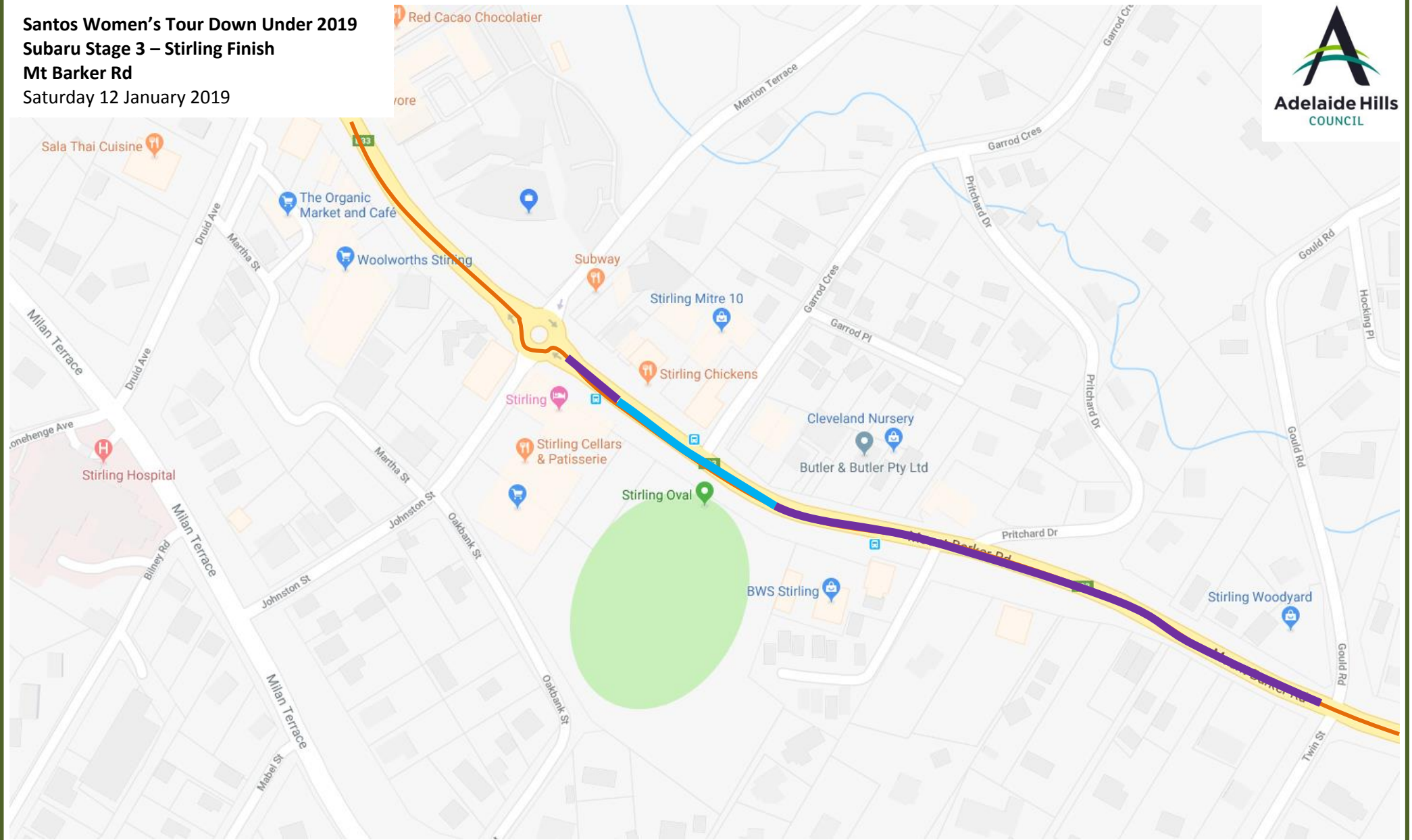
