Proof of residency required. Residents are required to unload their green waste. Council staff are not required to assist but can do so at their own discretion.

If an 'Extreme 75 or above' or 'Catastrophic' fire danger day is declared by the CFS, this service will be cancelled.

Accepted items

Clean residential green organics including prunings, leaves and small branches up to 100mm diameter.

Loads are limited to a 7x5 trailer size (no limit to visits made).

Recycling Process:

Council mulches the organics collected and then on-sells it as nutrient rich mulch.

The mulch can be purchased from the Heathfield Resource Recovery Centre located at 32 Scott Creek Road, Heathfield.

Pest or environmental plants can be disposed of at the Heathfield Resource Recovery Centre for a fee or placed into an organic kerbside bin.
