Re: Santos Tour Down Under - Men's Schwalbe Stage 6 Finish | Unley to Mount Lofty

Santos Tour Down Under is returning to the Adelaide Hills with Stage 6 of the Men's race finishing at Mount Lofty on **Sunday 21 January 2024**, at approximately 2:31pm. This letter and the attached handout and map explain how the race may impact you.

Road closures in your area

We have included a handout which further explains the road closures. To enable the event to run smoothly and safely some **road closures and access restrictions** will be put in place. This will allow building and removal of infrastructure and barriers. Your regular travel routes and parking locations may be affected, so please familiarise yourself with these changes, plan accordingly and inform any other family members, customers or staff.

Parking restrictions

There will be some parking restrictions which have been identified in the map and handout attached.

Race route details

Schwalbe Men's Stage 6 will start in Unley at 11:10am and travel south through Kangarilla and Meadows before coming into the Hills via Mylor. Riders will then complete two and a half loops of Summertown, Uraidla, Carey Gully, Bridgewater, Aldgate, Stirling and Crafers. We expect the first pass through Crafers around 1:00pm before the final finish at approximately 2:31pm just before the entrance to Mount Lofty Summit after the climb from Crafers. Race Information

Race start at 11:10am (Unley)

Race passing at 1:05pm (Mount Lofty Summit Road at finish line) Race passing at 1:48pm (Mount Lofty Summit Road at finish line)

Race finish at 2:31pm (Mount Lofty Summit Road)

Road Closure Information (see map attached)

Complete closure and parking restrictions from 6:00am – 6:30pm:

• Mount Lofty Summit Road from Cleland Wildlife Park to Reynolds Drive (including all side streets)

Road closures from 1:00pm – 4:00pm:

- Crafers Interchange ramp from Adelaide from South Eastern Freeway to Mount Lofty Summit Road
- Waverley Ridge Road from Crafers Main Street to the Interchange Ramp to Adelaide
- Stirling Interchange ramp from Adelaide from South Eastern Freeway to Avenue Road
- Stirling Interchange ramp from Mount Barker from South Eastern Freeway to Avenue Road
- Bridgewater Interchange ramp from Adelaide from South Eastern Freeway to Carey Gully Road
- Bridgewater Interchange ramp from Mount Barker from South Eastern Freeway to Carey Gully Road

Crafers, Stirling and Bridgewater freeway exits will be impacted by the race from 1:00pm – 4:00pm with closures managed by SA Police. Whilst they will aim to facilitate opening between loops, this will be dependent on race conditions on the day.

Closure times have been put in place for public safety and to allow set up and pack down of event infrastructure. Tow away zones will be installed prior to the event to ensure the road is completely clear for the race.

Business and resident access only from 6:00am – 6:30pm:

- Mount Lofty Summit Road from Greenhill Road to Cleland Wildlife Park (including all side streets)
- Mount Lofty Summit Road from Reynolds Drive to Main Street, Crafers (including all side streets)

Parking restrictions:

- No parking both sides on Mount Lofty Summit Road from Crafers Main Street to 70m north of Pottery Drive from 6:00am – 4:00pm
- No parking both sides on Mount Lofty Summit Road from Mawson Drive to 60m south of Mawson Drive from 6:00am – 4:00pm
- No parking both sides on Main Street, Crafers from Piccadilly Road to Mount Lofty Summit Road from 6:00am 4:00pm

Tow away zones will be installed prior to the event to ensure the road is completely clear for the race.

Rolling road closures

The remainder of the event route will operate under 'rolling' road closures – SA Police will temporarily halt traffic as the race passes with the support of trained traffic marshals. Please note there may be extensive rolling road closures between 12:00pm – 3:00pm.
