**Re: Santos Tour Down Under – Women's Stage 2 Finish | Glenelg to Stirling**

**Santos Tour Down Under** is returning to the Adelaide Hills with Stage 2 of the Women's race finishing in Stirling on **Saturday 13 January 2024**, at approximately 2:23pm. This letter and the attached handout and map explain how the race may impact you.

**Road closures in your area**

We have included a handout which further explains the road closures. To enable the event to run smoothly and safely some **road closures and access restrictions** will be put in place. This will allow building and removal of infrastructure and barriers. Your regular travel routes and parking locations may be affected, so please familiarise yourself with these changes, plan accordingly and inform any other family members, customers or staff.

**Parking restrictions**

There will be some parking restrictions which have been identified in the map and handout attached.

**Race route details**

Women's Stage 2 sees riders start in Glenelg at 11:10am then travel south through Clarendon, Meadows and Echunga. Riders then enter the Hills completing two loops through Heathfield, Bradbury, Mylor, Aldgate and Stirling. We expect the first pass through Stirling just after 1:00pm before the finish at approximately 2:23pm on Mount Barker Road by Stirling Oval. ## **Race Information**

Race start at 11:10am (Glenelg)  
Race passing at 1:12pm (Mount Barker Road at finish line)  
Race passing at 1:47pm (Mount Barker Road at finish line)  
Race finish at 2:23pm (Mount Barker Road, Stirling)

## **Road Closure Information** (see map attached)

**Complete closure and parking restrictions** from 6:00am – 6:30pm:

- Mount Barker Road, Stirling, from Gould Road / Twin Street to Merrion Terrace / Johnston Street

*Closure times have been put in place for public safety and to allow set up and pack down of event infrastructure. Tow away zones will be installed prior to the event to ensure the road is completely clear for the race.*

### **Parking restrictions:**

- No parking Stirling Oval car park from 6:00am – 6:30pm
- No parking both sides on Avenue Road from Mount Barker Road to Milan Terrace from 12:00pm – 3:00pm
- No parking both sides on Oakbank Street from Johnston Street to Stirling Oval entrance from 12:00pm – 4:00pm

*Tow away zones will be installed prior to the event to ensure the road is completely clear for the race.*

### **Detours**

Detours will be in place to direct traffic, please refer to signage on the day.

### **Rolling road closures**

The remainder of the event route will operate under '**rolling**' road closures – SA Police will temporarily halt traffic as the race passes with the support of trained traffic marshals. Please note there may be extensive rolling road closures between 12:30pm – 3:00pm.
