The South Australian Living Artists (SALA) Festival is a statewide festival of visual art. The Summit Community Centre will once again be participating in SALA with our exhibition 'Adelaide Hills Abundance'.

We are inviting children between the ages of 5 – 15 to enter an art competition, with entries displayed during the exhibition.

### Artwork Display Dates

Monday 3 August – Thursday 10 September, 2026  
9:00am – 3:00pm, Monday – Thursday

### Delivery of Artwork

All artwork must be delivered by 3pm on Wednesday 15 July 2026. You can deliver during our opening hours (Monday – Thursday, 9am to 3pm).

### Collection of Artwork





If you would like to have your artwork returned, you can collect it from Monday 14 September during our opening hours (Monday – Thursday, 9am to 3pm).

**All artwork must be collected by Monday 5 October.**

## Competition Theme

The theme of this year's exhibition is 'Adelaide Hills Abundance' - artwork reflecting the abundance of flora, fauna, landscapes and food of the Adelaide Hills.

Your artwork might explore:

-  **Flora** - Native wildflowers, trees and gardens.
-  **Fauna** - Native wildlife, birds and insects.
-  **Landscapes** - Rolling hills, creeks, valleys, farms and forests.
-  **Food** - Local food production, seasonal harvests and markets.

# Competition Guidelines

- The competition is open to anyone aged 5 – 15 years.
- All artwork must relate to the theme of **Adelaide Hills Abundance** as outlined above.
- One artwork only per entrant.
- Artwork must be on paper only (NOT board or canvas).
- Artwork must be unmounted and unframed.
- Artworks must be no smaller than A4 (210 × 297 mm) and no bigger than A3 (420 × 297 mm) and can be either portrait (vertical) or landscape (horizontal).
- Any art materials or combination of art materials may be used (eg paint, pencil, pastels, charcoal, ink, paper collage) but the artwork must be two-dimensional.
- No photos or computer-generated images (digital or AI) will be accepted.
- Do not roll or fold your artwork as this will make it difficult to display.
- Please glue the entry form to the back of your artwork.
- The Summit Community Centre may refuse any entry that is not appropriate or does not fit the theme or the criteria listed above.
- Entries will be displayed at The Summit Community Centre during the 'Adelaide Hills Abundance SALA Exhibition from Monday 3 August – Thursday 10 September 2026.
- Any entries not collected by Monday 5 October will not be kept.

## Prizes

There are three age categories:

5 - 8 years

9 - 12 years

13 - 15 years

Entries will be voted for by the public during the SALA exhibition. The best artwork in each category will win an art pack to the value of \$50.

Winners will be announced and contacted as soon as possible after the end of the exhibition.

Winning entries including the name of the young artist, may be featured on the Adelaide Hills Council Community Centres and Adelaide Hills Council Facebook pages and website and electronic newsletters.
