The South Australian Living Artists (SALA) Festival is a statewide festival of visual art. The Summit Community Centre will once again be participating in SALA with our exhibition 'Adelaide Hills Connections'.

We are inviting young artists between the ages of 5 - 18 to enter an art competition, with entries displayed during the exhibition.

Artwork Display Dates

Monday 4 August – Thursday 11 September, 2025 9:00am – 3:00pm, Monday – Thursday

Delivery of Artwork

All artwork must be delivered by 3pm on Wednesday 16 July 2025. You can deliver during our opening hours (Monday – Thursday, 9am to 3pm).

Collection of Artwork

If you would like to have your artwork returned, you can collect it from Monday 15 September during our opening hours (Monday – Thursday, 9am to 3pm).

All artwork must be collected by Monday 6 October.

Competition Theme

The theme of the competition is the same as the theme of the SALA exhibition, 'Adelaide Hills Connections – artwork reflecting connections to community, nature, environment and history of the Adelaide Hills'.

Your artwork might explore:

- **H** Community Shared stories, local people, events, or traditions
- 🜿 Nature The local landscape, seasons, flora and fauna
- • Environment Sustainability, bushfire recovery, human impact on the land
- Distory Indigenous heritage, early settlement, historical places or people

Competition Guidelines

- The competition is open to anyone aged 5 18 years.
- All artwork must relate to the theme of **Adelaide Hills Connections** as outlined above.
- One artwork only per entrant.
- Artwork must be on paper only (NOT board or canvas).
- Artwork must be unmounted and unframed.
- Artworks must be no smaller than A4 (210 × 297 mm) and no bigger than A3 (420 × 297 mm) and can be either portrait (vertical) or landscape (horizontal).
- Any art materials or combination of art materials may be used (eg paint, pencil, pastels, charcoal, ink, paper collage) but the artwork must be two-dimensional.
- No photos or computer-generated images (digital or AI) will be accepted.
- Do not roll or fold your artwork as this will make it difficult to display.
- Please glue the entry form to the back of your artwork.
- The Summit Community Centre may refuse any entry that is not appropriate or does not fit the theme or the criteria listed above.
- Entries will be displayed at The Summit Community Centre during the 'Adelaide Hills Connections' SALA Exhibition from Monday 4 August Thursday 11 September 2025.
- Any entries not collected by Monday 6 October will not be kept.

Prizes

There are four age categories:

5 - 8 years 9 - 12 years 13 - 15 years 16 - 18 years

Entries will be voted for by the public during the SALA exhibition The best artwork in each category will win an art pack to the value of \$50 for the 5-8 years and 9-12 years categories, and to the value of \$100 for the 13-15 years and 16-18 years categories.

Winners will be announced and contacted as soon as possible after the end of the exhibition.

Winning entries including the name of the young artist, may be featured on the Adelaide Hills Council Community Centres and Adelaide Hills Council Facebook pages and website and electronic newsletters.
