

Youth Incentive Grants Application Guidelines 2025

Welcome to the Adelaide Hills Council Community Grants Program

Council provides individual Youth Incentive Grants to assist young residents to participate in representative sporting, cultural, or civic participation activities.

How much can be applied for and when?

Youth Incentive Grants are once-off donations of \$100 for individuals to attend representative activities.

These may include sporting, cultural, or civic participation endeavours.

Grants will be limited to a single application per applicant per calendar year.

Youth Incentive Grant funds will be released in two allocations being for the January to June and July to December periods. Grants will be available until the allocated budget is exhausted.

Eligibility of the applicant

- Any young person aged under 25 who lives in the Adelaide Hills Council district is welcome to apply
- Youth Incentive Grants are only available to individuals. Team applications cannot be accepted
- Youth Incentive Grants will provide applicants with support for a single event or activity only

Eligibility of the event or activity

Grant funding will not be provided for:

- Commercial or party-political activities
- Religious activities
- The reimbursement of funds already spent prior to receiving approval (applicants cannot seek funds retrospectively)
- Services that form part of regular compulsory school curriculum activities. This grant cannot be used for school or tertiary study costs
- Activities for the purpose of general fundraising or sponsorship

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What will the Youth Incentive Grant be used for? Information required

We ask that the young person applying provide us with a brief summary (approx. 150 words) about the activity that they are participating in and how the Youth Incentive Grant will assist them.

How to apply

To apply for a Youth Incentive Grant applicants must complete an online application form available on the Adelaide Hills Council website:

Applications must include the following details:

- The activity that you are requiring support for (name of the event, date, and location)
- Applicant's name, date of birth, postal address
- The bank account details (BSB, account number, account name) that you wish the grant to be paid into if your application is successful
- Applicants must include evidence of their selection or invitation to the event. This can be a letter or email of the governing body of the event
