Outcome of the Adelaide Hills Council Supplementary Election

Adelaide Hills Council congratulates three new Elected Members: Lisa Clare Woolcock, Richard Gladigau and Alex Trescowthick.

After the distribution of preferences, Lisa Clare Woolcock obtained 1,846 votes and was declared elected to Ranges Ward.

Lisa is a Stirling local and single mum to a 9 year old son, with over two decades of experience in people-centric industries including hospitality, tourism, business development and stakeholder engagement.

After the distribution of preferences, Alex Trescowthick obtained 1,113 votes and was declared elected to Valleys Ward.

Alex is a vineyard owner, winemaker, and President of the Adelaide Hills Wine Region Association, with practical experience in regional leadership, sustainability, and small business. He also serves on the wine region's Environment Sub-Committee, advocating for responsible land management and environmental stewardship.

Richard Gladigau obtained 1,155 first preference votes and was declared elected to Valleys Ward.

Richard has lived near Mt Torrens all his life. He runs two dairy farms supplying local cheese factories. Richard has been involved in state and national boards, including Dairy Farmers Milk Co-op, SA Dairyfarmers Association (12 years) and Australian Dairy Farmers (6 years, 2 years as President). These roles have developed his skills in leadership, governance, advocacy and strategic planning.
