

Martungka Natural Burial Ground

Officially opened in 2024, Martungka (Kaurna for 'in remembrance') is a dedicated natural burial ground within the Kersbrook Cemetery. Martungka offers a unique final resting place for natural burials in the beautiful Adelaide Hills.

In natural burials, no chemical or embalming fluids are used and to allow remains to decompose naturally, the deceased is buried in an environmentally sustainable casket or shroud.

To preserve the natural habitat of Martungka, there are no headstones, flowers or vases at the graveside. Locations of burials are mapped and recorded using GPS and microchip ensuring current and future generations can locate the place of burial.

Interment rights in Martungka are for 100 years and can be purchased 'pre-need'. Sites are allocated on a next available basis at the time of burial.



Cemeteries





Adelaide Hills Council manages 13 active cemeteries and has the care and control of three inactive cemeteries throughout the area.

Plots are available for single, double and triple depth burials as well as positions for the interment of cremated remains.

Interment rights can be purchased for 50 years, 100 years or in perpetuity.

To apply for a new interment right, applicants should complete an application form and email to the Council or contact Council's Cemeteries Officer for assistance.
