Assessment Panel (CAP) as a Relevant Authority under the Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016 & General

Regulations - Instrument C

For: Decision

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Council Assessment Panel (CAP) was established by the Council on 26 September 2017 under Section 83 of the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016*.

Section 100 of the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* (**PDI Act**) allows a relevant authority, other than an accredited professional, to delegate its powers and functions under this Act. The relevant authorities under the **PDI Act** are the Minister, the State Planning Commission, an assessment panel appointed by a joint planning board, an assessment panel appointed by a council, an assessment panel constituted by the Minister, an assessment manager, an accredited professional and a council. Thus the CAP, the Council and the Assessment Manager can all sub-delegate their powers and functions.

Delegations from the Council Assessment Panel to staff were last adopted by CAP on 10 February 2021 in readiness for the full implementation of the **PDI Act** on 19 March 2021. The delegations were based upon model delegations provided by the Local Government Association (LGA) at the time. The delegations included sub-delegation of powers and functions as a relevant authority to the Assessment Manager and sub-delegation of powers and functions in relation to building rules matters to the Administration. The Assessment Manager in turn is able to delegate these functions to staff.

Since adoption of the further amendments to Instrument C under the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* and Regulations by CAP on 10 February 2021, further amendments have been made.

The amendments include new delegations in relation to:

- the powers pursuant to the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure (General)*Regulations 2017 (the **PDI General Regulations**) and the State Planning Commission
 Practice Direction 14 Site Contamination in relation to site contamination investigations for development proposals
- the powers pursuant to the State Planning Commission Practice Direction 16 Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Scheme and the requirements of the Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Scheme
- the powers pursuant to Regulation 31 for verification of development applications

Corresponding to the new delegations for land relating to Practice Direction 14 Site Contamination the amendments also include deletion of provisions that are superseded by the Practice Direction.

The entire set of delegations in Instrument C is included as **Attachment 1** of this report for the consideration of CAP.

RECOMMENDATION

- That, having considered a review of the Council Assessment Panel Delegations as presented, the Council Assessment Panel hereby revokes all previous delegations to the Assessment Manager and Council (Elected Body) for powers and functions under Instrument C of the Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016 and General Regulations 2017.
- 2. In exercise of the power contained in Section 100 of the Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016, the powers and functions under the Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016 and statutory instruments made thereunder contained in the proposed Instrument of Delegation (Instrument C) (Attachment 1 of the Report dated 14 July 2021) are hereby delegated this 14thth day of July 2021 to the Assessment Manager and the Administration subject to the conditions and/or limitations, if any, specified herein or in the Schedule of Conditions in in the proposed Instrument of Delegation.
- 3. Such powers and functions of Instrument C may be further delegated by the Assessment Manager in accordance with Section 100(2) (c) of the Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016 as the Assessment Manager sees fit, unless otherwise indicated herein or, in the Schedule of Conditions in the proposed Instrument of Delegation.
- 4. That the Assessment Manager be authorised to make any formatting, nomenclature or other minor changes to Instrument C during the period of currency.

1. GOVERNANCE

Legal Implications

The Council is required to have an Assessment Panel in place which is currently comprised of independent members and up to one Council Elected Member.

The *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* (PDI Act) was assented to by the Governor on 21 April 2016. On 1 October 2017 the operation of Council Assessment Panel (CAP) pursuant to Sections 82 and 83 of the PDI Act commenced and the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure (General) Regulations 2017* [the PDI General Regulations] came into operation.

There is a requirement under the **PDI Act and Regulations** for delegations. Pursuant to Section 100(2) (c) of the **PDI Act** the planning functions and powers related to the delegations in **Attachment 1** are recommended to be delegated to the Assessment Manager.

Customer Service and Community/Cultural Implications

All applications which have been publicly notified and have representors who wish to be heard are reported to the CAP for consideration unless delegations allow otherwise. This ensures that such members of the community have an opportunity to present their views about a specific development and its potential impacts to the CAP. Other types of development which do not require public notification, are assessed by other relevant authorities, including Accredited Professionals, the Assessment Manager and the State Commission Assessment Panel.

Engagement/Consultation

Community consultation on the Planning Reforms has been undertaken by the State Planning Commission and Council.

No community engagement or consultation is required for new legislation or the delegation of powers and functions, as this is the administrative governance, required out of necessity.

2. THE NEED FOR DELEGATIONS

The relevant authorities under the **PDI Act** are the Minister, the State Planning Commission, an assessment panel appointed by a joint planning board, an assessment panel appointed by a council, an assessment panel constituted by the Minister, an assessment manager, an accredited professional and a council. The CAP and the Assessment Manager are the relevant authorities rather than the Council. Additionally the CAP is also the relevant authority for the building assessment functions.

The functions of an Assessment Manager as prescribed in Section 87 (e) of the **PDI Act** extend beyond acting as a relevant authority under the Act. They also include being responsible for managing the staff and operations of the CAP and providing advice to the CAP. Out of administrative necessity this requires that there are delegations to the Assessment Manager from CAP.

The CAP typically considers approximately 5% of the development applications lodged with Council and thus it is necessary for the CAP to delegate its planning functions and powers to Council staff for the assessment of the remaining 95% of development applications. As mentioned above under the **PDI Act** the building functions and powers are now bestowed on the CAP. Section 99(1) of the **PDI Act** permits a CAP to refer the building rules assessment function onto the Council, and only then can Council become the relevant authority.

Under the **PDI Act** the CAP and Assessment Managers as relevant authorities in their own right, will both be respondents to planning appeals in their own right rather than the Council. However the Council is directly responsible for the costs associated with both appeals and the activities of its CAP and its Assessment Manager pursuant to Section 83 (1) (h) (ii) and 87(f) of the **PDI Act.**

The model delegations prepared for the LGA and consist of the following four instruments:

Instrument A - Delegations for the Powers of a Council as a Designated Authority
 Instrument B - Delegations for the Powers of a Council as a Relevant Authority
 Instrument C - Delegations for the Powers of a Council Assessment Panel
 Instrument D - Delegations for the Powers of an Assessment Manager

3. AMENDMENTS TO DELEGATIONS FROM CAP (INSTRUMENT C)

The amendments include new delegations in relation to:

- the powers pursuant to the PDI General Regulations and the State Planning Commission Practice Direction 14 Site Contamination in relation to site contamination investigations for development proposals (7 new delegations necessary to administer the requirements and process defined in the Practice Direction)
- the powers pursuant to the State Planning Commission Practice Direction 16 Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Scheme and the requirements of the Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Scheme (5 new delegations necessary to administer the requirements and process defined in the Practice Direction and the Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Scheme)
- the powers pursuant to Regulation 31 for verification of development applications and inclusion of additional detail and re-numbering

Corresponding to the new delegations relating to Practice Direction 14 Site Contamination the amendments also include deletion of provisions that are superseded by the Practice Direction (2 delegations deleted).

The entire set of delegations in Instrument C is included as **Attachment 1** of this report for the consideration of CAP and the "tracked change" version of Instrument C highlighting the amendments and the renumbering is included as **Attachment. 2**. A copy of the two Practice Directions and Urban Tree Canopy referred to in the new delegations are included as **Attachments 3**, **4** and **5**.

Aligned with good governance practice, it is recommended that the delegations by CAP in Instrument C be revoked and readopted in their entirety for completeness and to avoid confusion i.e. there is a point of in time where the entire Instrument is adopted.

4. SUMMARY

The **PDI Act and PDI General Regulations** delegations from the CAP (Instrument C) to staff have been updated using the updated model delegations provided by the Local Government Association.

It is recommended that the delegations as detailed in **Attachment 1** of this report be adopted by the CAP and the previously adopted Instrument of Delegation under the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* and Regulations - Powers of an Assessment Panel (Instrument C) of 10 February 2021 be revoked.

PRACTICE DIRECTION 14

Site Contamination Assessment 2021



This practice direction is issued by the State Planning Commission under sections 42 and 127 of the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016*.

Introduction

Section 42 of the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* allows the State Planning Commission (the "Commission") to issue practice directions for the purposes of the Act. Generally, practice directions specify procedural requirements or steps in connection with a matter arising under the Act. In certain cases, the Act provides that a particular matter may be addressed or dealt with by a practice direction.

Section 4 of the Act sets out rules that relate to a change in the use of land, which is a form of development under the Act. This practice direction is part of a scheme that provides for requirements that apply in relation to the assessment of potential site contamination when land use changes to a more sensitive use or where a land division proposes a sensitive use. Because site contamination is linked to land use, bringing about a change in land use can cause site contamination (under section 103D(2) of the *Environment Protection Act 1993* and regulation 51 of the *Environment Protection Regulations 2009*) even though the person who brought about the change of use may not be the original polluter.

In particular, this practice direction sets out some forms and related requirements that will support various requirements under the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure (General) Regulations 2017* when a relevant authority is considering an application for planning consent where the application proposes a change in land use to a more sensitive use or, in the case of land division, the application proposes a sensitive use. This practice direction also provides specified conditions (pursuant to section 127(1)(b) of the Act) for development authorisations where remediation may be necessary before occupation or use of land the subject of the application.

Practice direction

Part 1 - Preliminary

1 - Citation

This practice direction may be cited as the *State Planning Commission Practice Direction 14 (Site Contamination Assessment)*.

2 - Commencement of operation

This practice direction will come into operation on 19 March 2021.

3 - Objects of practice direction

The objects of this practice direction are:

- (a) to support site contamination assessment steps that must be taken when land use is proposed to be changed to a more sensitive use or, with respect to land division, where a sensitive use is proposed, and there is reason to believe that site contamination exists or may exist because of various activities or conditions; and
- (b) to set out forms and other requirements that are contemplated by provisions of the Planning, Development and Infrastructure (General) Regulations 2017 that relate to assessment and remediation of site contamination in connection with applications for planning consent; and
- (c) to specify conditions that will apply in connection with a planning consent for land that may be subject to site contamination; and
- (d) to provide guidance and other information associated with the assessment and remediation of site contamination.

4 - Interpretation

In this practice direction, unless the contrary intention appears—

Act means the Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016;

EPA means the Environment Protection Authority;

exposure in relation to site contamination means an exposure pathway that a chemical substance takes from its source to reach a human population, such as incidental ingestion of surface soil or indoor dust, indoor and outdoor inhalation of dust, or consumption of home grown produce;

class 1 activity means a class 1 activity specified in Schedule 1 undertaken in the course of a business;

class 2 activity means a class 2 activity specified in Schedule 1 undertaken in the course of a business;

class 3 activity means a class 3 activity specified in Schedule 1 undertaken in the course of a business, other than an activity that is also a class 1 or class 2 activity;

human population in relation to site contamination means a human receptor (for example a child resident or adult employee);

more sensitive use in relation to land—see clause 5;

National Environment Protection (Assessment of Site Contamination) Measure 1999 means the National Environment Protection (Assessment of Site Contamination) Measure 1999 (prepared under the National Environment Protection Council Act 1994 of the Commonwealth), as in force from time to time;

notification of site contamination of underground water means a notification made under section 83A of the *Environment Protection Act 1993* as shown on the South Australian Property and Planning Atlas;

Note—The online atlas and search facility established under section 50 of the Act (known as the South Australian Property and Planning Atlas (SAPPA) shows sites that are subject to notification of site contamination of underground water and Groundwater Prohibition Areas under 'Layers' then navigate to 'Planning and Building' > 'Planning Reference'.

potentially contaminating activity means a class 1 activity, class 2 activity or class 3 activity;

relevant regulations means those parts of the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure* (General) Regulations 2017 that are concerned with site contamination or potential site contamination:

remediation has the same meaning as in the Environment Protection Act 1993;

sensitive use is a use described in item 1 or 2 of the land use sensitivity hierarchy table in clause 5, subject to clause 6;

Note—Section 14 of the Acts Interpretation Act 1915 provides that an expression used in an instrument made under an Act has, unless the contrary intention appears, the same meaning as in the Act under which the instrument was made.

Part 2 - Land use sensitivity

5 - Land use sensitivity

- (1) Subject this clause, for the purposes of determining whether a change in land use is to a more sensitive use for the purposes of the relevant regulations and the Planning and Design Code, the relevant authority must have regard to the land uses specified in the land use sensitivity hierarchy in Table 1.
- (2) In the event that the proposed or existing land use is not specified in Table 1, the relevant authority must have regard to:
 - (a) the sensitivity of the human populations proposed to be using the land following the change in use; and
 - (b) the potential for exposure of those populations to chemicals from site contamination following the change of use.
- (3) In the event of inconsistency, the level of sensitivity of a land use in Table 1 prevails.
- (4) Table 1 sets out the level of sensitivity in classes of land use that are represented in items 1 to 7 decreasing on a scale from the most sensitive uses specified in item 1 to the least sensitive uses specified in item 7.

(5) The following qualifications apply in relation to Table 1:

- (a) the land use sensitivity classification for a mixed or multi-use proposal will be taken to be that of the most sensitive use of the uses to which the proposed development relates:
- (b) if the land use changes from a use represented in an item in the table to another use represented within the same item (for example from tourist accommodation to a hospital: both uses falling within item 4), the change of use will not be taken to constitute a change to a more sensitive use;
- (c) if the proposed or previous land use is not represented in the land use sensitivity hierarchy, the use closest in nature to the use specified in the hierarchy should be considered;
- (d) in circumstances where there is no current land use, the proposed use will be taken to be a more sensitive use, other than where:
 - (i) the immediate previous use was for a residential purpose; or
 - (ii) the relevant allotment was lawfully created for a residential purpose; or
 - (iii) the proposed use is industrial.

6 - Definition of sensitive use

For the purpose of the definition of **sensitive use** in the relevant regulations, and clause 2A(1)(b) of Schedule 8 of those regulations, a use will not be regarded as a sensitive use in the case of land division if the allotment has already been lawfully created for a residential purpose.

Part 3 - Class 1, 2 and 3 activities

7 - Classification of activities

Class 1, 2 and 3 activities are defined in Schedule 1.

Note—In the tables in Schedule 1, unless the contrary intention appears, the term 'listed substance' has the same meaning as in the *Environment Protection Regulations 2009*; and the terms 'resource recovery', 'waste' and 'treatment' have the same meaning as in the *Environment Protection Act 1993*.

Part 4 - Forms

8 - Site contamination declaration form

- (1) A site contamination declaration form under the relevant regulations must be in the form set out in Schedule 2.
- (2) If an application for planning consent envisages the undertaking of development in stages (in accordance with section 119 (12) of the Act), a site contamination declaration form can be provided for separate stages.

9 - Preliminary site investigation report

- (1) A preliminary site investigation report under the relevant regulations must be sufficient to:
 - (a) identify potential onsite and offsite sources of contamination (known as **potentially contaminating activities**); and
 - (b) determine potential chemical substances of concern; and
 - (c) identify areas of potential contamination; and
 - (d) identify potentially affected media (being soil, water and vapour).
- (2) A preliminary site investigation report usually also includes:
 - (a) a desktop study to identify site characteristics site location, site layout, building construction, geological and the hydro-geological setting; and
 - (b) a site history identifying historical owners/operators/occupiers, land uses and activities; and
 - (c) a site inspection to validate anecdotal evidence or historical information and to identify additional evidence of potential site contamination; and
 - (d) interviews with site owners, operators and/or occupiers.
- (3) A preliminary site investigation report must be sufficient to provide an assessment of whether site contamination exists, may exist or is unlikely to exist.

10 - Statement of site suitability

A statement of site suitability under the relevant regulations and this practice direction must be in the form set out in Schedule 3.

Part 5 - Guidance associated with referral to EPA

11 - Guidance associated with referral to EPA

- (1) When a referral is triggered, the EPA should have regard to a range of factors in deciding the most appropriate person to determine site suitability (that is, a site contamination consultant or a site contamination auditor), including the following:
 - (a) site specific information; and
 - (b) the identified potentially contaminating activities; and
 - (c) the nature of the proposed use or uses; and
 - (d) the conceptual site model (which is critical to understanding the relationship between the source of contamination potential exposure and human populations) where relevant.

(2) The overall purpose of the referral is to ensure that an appropriate and proportionate assessment of site contamination or potential site contamination occurs.

Part 6 - Conditions

12 - Change of use where remediation is required after the issue of planning consent - section 127(1)(b) of Act

If a relevant authority is satisfied that a site is suitable for its intended use subject to remediation being undertaken and the relevant authority issues a planning consent without the remediation work having been carried out, the consent must be subject to Condition A, B or C as relevant:

Condition A: Where a certificate of occupancy is required

A certificate of occupancy must not be granted in relation to a building on the relevant site until a statement of site suitability is issued certifying that the required remediation has been undertaken and the land is suitable for the proposed use.

Condition B: Where a certificate of occupancy is not required

A person must not occupy the building for the purpose authorised under the development approval [insert development application number] until a statement of site suitability is issued certifying that the required remediation has been undertaken and the land is suitable for the proposed use.

Condition C: Where the application does not involve building work

A person must not use the relevant site for the purpose authorised under the development approval [insert development application number] until a statement of site suitability is issued certifying that the required remediation has been undertaken and the land is suitable for the proposed use.

13 – Land division where remediation is required after the issue of planning consent – section 127(1)(b) of Act

If a relevant authority is satisfied in relation to proposed land division that a site is suitable for its intended use subject to remediation being undertaken and the relevant authority issues a planning consent without the remediation work having been carried out, the consent must be subject to the following condition:

A land division certificate under section 138 of the Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016 must not be issued until a statement of site suitability is issued certifying that the required remediation has been undertaken and the land is suitable for the proposed use.

Part 7 - Related matters

14 - Guidance associated with level of investigation

 A site contamination declaration form and a preliminary site investigation report should be sufficient to provide an assessment of whether site contamination exists, may exist or is unlikely to exist.

- (2) No further assessment of site contamination is required for the purposes of planning consent if:
 - (a) the site contamination declaration form indicates that site contamination is unlikely to exist and the land is not located in a groundwater prohibition area; or
 - (b) the land is subject to a notation under section 103P of the *Environment Protection*Act 1993 on the relevant title that a site contamination audit report has been prepared in relation to the land within the previous 5 years and:
 - (i) the report states that—
 - (A) site contamination does not exist (or no longer exists) at the land; or
 - (B) the land is suitable for the proposed use or uses (without the need for any further remediation); or
 - (C) where remediation is, or remains, necessary for the proposed use (or range of uses), remediation work has been undertaken or will be undertaken (and the applicant has provided a written undertaking that the remediation works will be undertaken in association with the development); and
 - (ii) no other *class 1 activity* or *class 2 activity* has taken place at the land since the preparation of the site contamination audit report (as declared in the site contamination declaration form).

PRACTICE DIRECTION 16

Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Scheme 2021



This practice direction is issued by the State Planning Commission under section 42 of the *Planning*, *Development and Infrastructure Act 2016*.

Introduction

Section 42 of the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* (the Act) allows the State Planning Commission (the Commission) to issue practice directions for the purposes of the Act. Generally, practice directions specify procedural requirements or steps in connection with a matter arising under the Act. In certain cases, the Act requires a particular matter to be addressed or dealt with by a practice direction.

This practice direction is being made by the Commission to support the operation of section 197, of the Act with respect to the operation of the Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Scheme established by the Minister.

Practice direction

Part 1 - Preliminary

1 - Citation

This practice direction may be cited as the *State Planning Commission Practice Direction 16* (*Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Scheme*) 2021.

2 - Commencement of operation

This practice direction will come into operation on the day on which it is published on the SA Planning Portal.

3 - Object of practice direction

The object of this practice direction is to specify certain procedural matters required for the effective operation of the Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Scheme.

4 - Interpretation

In this practice direction, unless the contrary intention appears –

Act means the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act* 2016.

Commission means the State Planning Commission.

Council means a council constituted under the Local Government Act 1999.

Council Fund means an urban trees fund established by a council under section 200 of the Act (which includes an urban trees fund established under section 50B of the *Development Act 1993*

which continues in operation pursuant to Schedule 8 (Transitional Provisions) section 33(3) of the Act).

Council Fund Designated Area means the designated area of a Council Fund as provided under section 200(1) of the Act.

Designated Soil Type means a designated soil type as that term is defined in the Scheme.

DTS/DPF Policy means the deemed-to-satisfy criteria and the designated performance feature 1.1, as provided for in the Overlay.

Fund means the Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Fund established under the Scheme.

Overlay means the Urban Tree Canopy Overlay in the Planning and Design Code.

Regulations means the Planning, Development and Infrastructure (General) Regulations 2017.

Scheme means the Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Scheme established by the Minister for Planning and Local Government under section 197 of the Act.

Note: Section 14 of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1915* provides that an expression used in an instrument made under an Act has, unless the contrary intention appears, the same meaning as in the Act under which the instrument was made.

Part 2 – Payments to the Fund

5 - Information required for development applications

A development application which proposes a dwelling within the Overlay must include, when lodged for planning consent under section 102(1)(a) of the Act, an election from the applicant to:

- (1) make payment into the Fund as required under the Scheme; or
- (2) plant a tree (or trees) as provided in the DTS/DPF Policy in the Overlay; or
- (3) reserve consideration of the DTS/DPF Policy in the Overlay, as provided for in the Code and under section 102(4) of the Act.

6 - Reserved Matter

Where an applicant has elected to reserve consideration of the DTS/DPF Policy in the Overlay, as provided for in the Code and under section 102(4) of the Act, in order to satisfy the reserved matter, and at any time prior to granting of development authorisation, the applicant may:

- (1) make an election to plant a tree (or trees) as provided in the DTS/DPF Policy in the Overlay; or
- (2) if required, provide documents which are considered by the relevant authority as sufficient to confirm whether the relevant development site includes a Designated Soil Type; and
- (3) make an election to make payment into the Fund as required under the Scheme.

7 - Process for payments to the Fund

Where an applicant has elected to make a payment into the Fund, in lieu of planting a tree (or trees) as provided in the DTS/DPF Policy in the Overlay, the payment will:

- (1) be made via the Development Application Processing (DAP) system on the SA Planning Portal at http://plan.sa.gov.au; and
- (2) be verified by the relevant authority as being correct in accordance with the Scheme, prior to the granting of development authorisation under the Act.

Part 3 – Application of Council Funds

8 - Development within Council Fund Designated Areas

Where a development application relates to a site which is located both within a Council Fund Designated Area and within the Overlay:

- (1) Where an applicant has elected to make a payment into the Fund, in lieu of planting a tree (or trees) as provided in the DTS/DPF Policy in the Overlay, such payment will be made into the Fund, as opposed to into a Council Fund; and/or
- (2) Except as provided in clause 8(3), where an applicant has elected to plant a tree (or trees) as provided in the DTS/DPF Policy in the Overlay, the relevant authority must not impose a condition on a development authorisation under the Act which requires payment into a Council Fund; and/or
- (3) Where the development application includes the killing, destruction or removal of a regulated or significant tree, the relevant authority may impose a condition requiring payment into a Council Fund, irrespective of an election by the applicant to plant a tree or make a payment into the Fund as provided under the Scheme.

Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Scheme

This scheme is established by the Minister for Planning and Local Government under section 197 of the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016.*

Introduction

Section 197 of the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016* (the *Act*) allows the Minister for Planning and Local Government (the *Minister*) to establish a scheme that is designed to support or facilitate:

- a) development that may be in the public interest or otherwise considered by the designated entity as being appropriate in particular circumstances (including by the provision of facilities at a different site); or
- b) planning or development initiatives that will further the objects of the Act or support the principles that relate to the planning system established by the Act; or
- c) any other initiative or policy
 - i. designated by the Planning and Design Code; or
 - ii. prescribed by regulations made under the Act.

This scheme is being established by the Minister as a scheme for contributions to be made to a fund to be called the Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Fund (the *fund*).

As provided for under s197(3)(b) of the Act, the scheme includes the ability for provisions specified in the Urban Tree Canopy Overlay within the Planning and Design Code (the *Code*) to be varied as set out in this scheme. Specifically, the scheme provides that where an applicant seeks development approval for a dwelling in a location covered by the Code Urban Tree Canopy Overlay, the applicant may in specified circumstances elect to make a contribution to the fund instead of planting a tree or trees as required under the Deemed-to-Satisfy Criteria or Designated Performance Feature set out in the overlay (depending on the classification of the development).

Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Scheme

1. Citation

This scheme may be cited as the *Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Scheme*.

2. Commencement of operation

This scheme will commence operation on the date published on the SA Planning Portal.

3. Object of scheme

This scheme is designed to support the planning initiative reflected in the desired outcome for the Urban Tree Canopy Overlay in the Code so as to promote development that preserves and enhances the urban tree canopy through the planting of new trees and the retention of existing trees by providing that an applicant for development approval may, in appropriate cases, elect to make a contribution to a fund instead of planting the trees required by the overlay, and thus further the objects of the Act in the manner contemplated by section 197(2)(b) of the Act.

4. Interpretation

(1) In this scheme, unless the contrary intention appears:

Act means the Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016; council means a council constituted under the Local Government Act 1999;

designated local government area means the whole of a local government area within which the overlay applies (even if the overlay only applies to a portion of that local government area);

designated soil type means the following soil types in accordance with Australian Standard AS2870:

- a) H1-D: Highly reactive clay sites, which may experience high ground movement (41-60 mm) from deep-seated moisture changes; or
- b) H2-D: Highly reactive clay sites, which may experience very high ground movement (61-75 mm) from deep-seated moisture changes; or
- c) E-D: Extremely reactive sites, which may experience extreme ground movement (>75 mm) from deep-seated moisture changes;

DTS/DPF policy means the deemed-to-satisfy criteria and the designated performance feature 1.1, as provided for in the overlay;

fund means the Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Fund established under this scheme;

overlay means the Urban Tree Canopy Overlay in the Code;

scheme means this Urban Tree Canopy Off-set Scheme;

tree size means tree sizes as described in Table 1 of the DTS/DPF policy.

- (2) This scheme is to be read and applied in conjunction with:
 - a) the requirements of the Act; and
 - b) the Code.

(3) A term used in this scheme that is defined in the Act has the same meaning in this scheme as it has in the Act (unless the contrary intention appears).

5. Establishment of fund

- (1) For the purposes of section 197(3)(a) of the Act, this scheme establishes a fund that consists of:
 - a) all amounts paid to the credit of the fund under clause 6(1); and
 - b) any income paid into the fund under clause 6(3).
- (2) The fund is intended to provide for the planting, establishment and maintenance of trees in the relevant area where it is not practicable or appropriate, in a particular case, to plant the trees that would otherwise be required in order to comply with the DTS/DPF policy.

6. Payments into fund

- (1) Where:
 - a) an applicant seeks planning consent for a dwelling in a location where the overlay applies; and
 - b) the site of the proposed development is located within either:
 - (i) a Housing Diversity Neighbourhood Zone, Urban Renewal Neighbourhood Zone or City Living Zone in the Code; or
 - (ii) an area with a designated soil type; and
 - c) the applicant elects to make a contribution to the fund in lieu of planting a tree (or trees) as provided for by the DTS/DPF policy in the overlay.

then payment must be made to the fund at the following rates:

Tree Size	Rate (\$ per tree)
Small	\$300
Medium	\$600
Large	\$1,200

(2) For the avoidance of doubt, where multiple trees are provided for in the DTS/DPF policy, an applicant may elect to make a contribution to the fund and also plant a tree (or trees), provided that the amount paid to the fund is equivalent to the shortfall in the number of trees provided for in the DTS/DPF policy.

- (3) Any money in the fund that is not for the time being required for the purpose of the fund may be invested by the Minister and any resultant income must be paid into the fund.
- (4) Where an applicant has elected to make a contribution to the fund under this scheme:
 - a) the relevant authority will impose a condition on the relevant development authorisation for planning consent requiring that payment of the amount specified in clause 6(1) must be made into the fund before the issue of development approval for the subject development application; and
 - b) payment must be made through the SA planning portal.

7. Variation of code

For the purposes of section 197(3)(b) of the Act, the overlay will apply as if it provided that a contribution to the fund in accordance with clause 6 of this scheme will be taken to form part of, and to satisfy, the DTS/DPF policy.

8. Payments from fund

Subject to any directions or approvals of the Treasurer made or given after consultation with the Minister under section 197(4)(b) of the Act:

- (1) money standing to the credit of the fund may be distributed by the Minister to a council within a designated local government area; and
- (2) the amount distributed to a council will be the total sum of moneys paid into the fund within the designated local government area for the relevant council in the previous financial year, which payment will be made following:
 - a) the end of the relevant financial year; or
 - b) following an application being made to the Minister by the relevant council, prior to the end of that financial year, at the Minister's discretion.

9. Use of money from fund

- (1) Money distributed from the fund may be used for any of the following purposes (and for no other purpose):
 - a) to provide for the planting, establishment and maintenance of trees within reserves or public land anywhere within a designated local government area; or
 - b) the purchase of land within a designated local government area to ensure:
 - (i) the preservation of trees; or

- (ii) that trees can be established in an area with a low urban tree canopy level or a demonstrated urban tree canopy loss.
- (2) Unless otherwise approved by the Minister, in relation to 9(1)(b), money from the fund must not be used:
 - (i) to purchase land at a value which exceeds the market value of the land (determined by the most recent valuation published by the Valuer-General of South Australia as at the date of purchase); or
 - (ii) towards legal costs, transfer fees, stamp duty or compensation arising from the compulsory acquisition of land.

10. Auditing

The fund must be audited by an auditor determined by the Minister at the end of each financial year and the audited accounts of the fund must be included as part of the annual report for the Act required under the *Public Sector Act 2009*.
