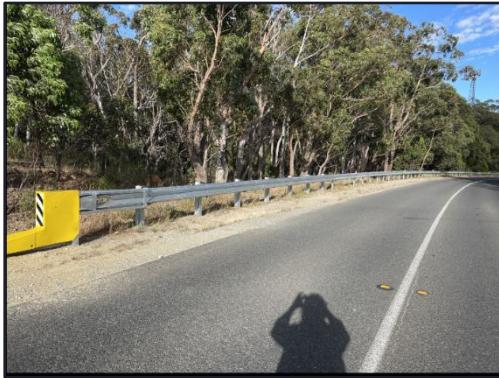


Carey Gully Road / Fowler Road Intersection

Guard rail replacements at the intersection of Carey Gully Road and Fowler Road intersection.



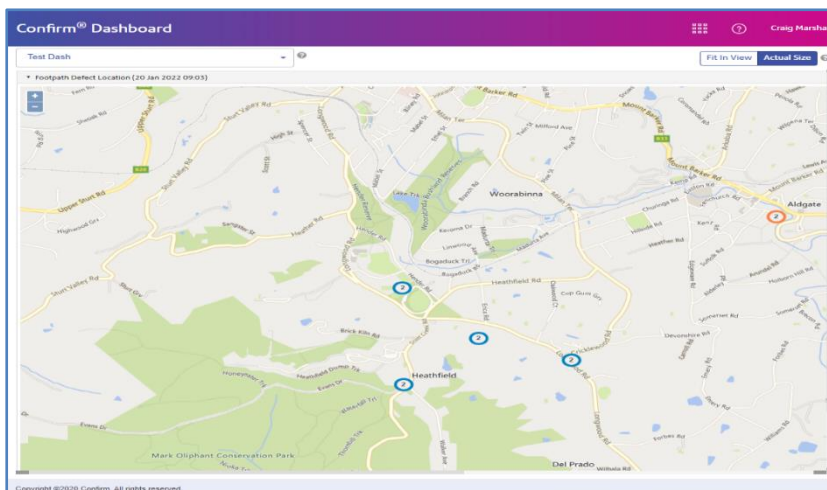
Hillcrest Avenue, replacement project



Asset Systems – Footpath Condition Assessment

Council is currently undertaking a footpath condition assessment, utilising our Graduate Engineering Student currently working with Civil Services and Mobile Confirm Asset Management System.

A total of 775 footpaths (asphalt, paved and concrete) are on the review list for condition and defects, and currently 561 have been completed this year already.

Merchant Road, Basket Range

Failed road embankment stabilisation and stormwater upgrade works have now been completed at Merchant road, Basket Range. Minor site tidy up works still to be carried out.

Work involved installing rock wall to failed embankment section – approximately 40m long, 3.5m-4.0m high and stormwater pits, kerb & gutter and swales to improve road side stormwater drainage and road widening.



Gumeracha Sports Courts Upgrade

Installation of the new 3.6m high chainmesh fencing and gates is complete. Marking out for the court set out and the installation of sports equipment has begun, with acrylic surfacing and line marking to follow in the coming weeks.



Mill Road Lobethal Emu Crossing

Construction is complete, with the safety fencing installed in late December 2021.



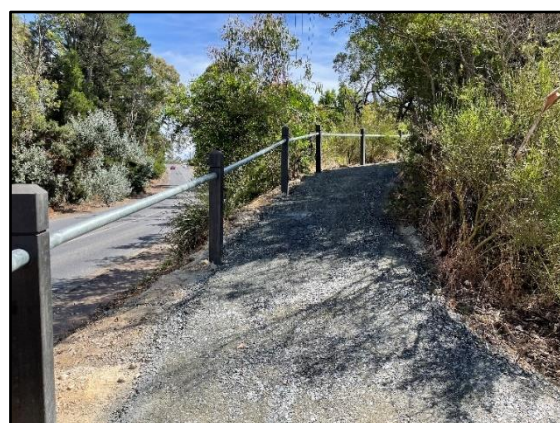
Footpath and Kerbing Renewals
